## **Important Requirements for Entry:**

Everyone over one year old must have **proof of a clear TB test as of October 1<sup>st</sup> or later.** (Free testing at Public Health Clinics)  
Must agree to a one time intake interview and have photo taken at time of first entry. You will be issued a shelter I.D. card.  
There is very limited, unsecured over-night storage for personal items. Toiletries and a change of clothes are allowed into the Armory in a clear plastic bag (provided).  
Sorry, we have no on site accommodations for pets.
